A New Fixture Among Lighting Design Firms

This weekend, at the International Contemporary Furniture Fair at the Javits center, Jason Miller and business partner Andrew Yang, a former editor for Wallpaper magazine, will debut Roll & Hill, their new lighting design company.

Some 40 pieces will also be on display at Great Jones Lum-

ber, in Noho, which is open to the public.

"It's kind of our coming-out party," said Mr. Miller, who is perhaps best known for his ceramic deer-antler lamps.

Roll & Hill consists of 11 different collections by nine different designers. Five pieces are sold at Design Within

Reach; others are available at stores nationwide.

"One boxy couch looks like the next boxy couch," Mr. Miller said. "But people are willing to pay a little more for lighting. It has a special place in interiors. It's very visible, it's hanging over everyone's heads." *Marshall Heyman*
